My brothers, both comedians in the family, used humor to get

through the worst days. One laugh in particular has become a running joke in our family: My dad, at 76, loves my mom to pieces, but is, well, let's face it, he's a little self-absorbed. Sometimes he's stuck in the den for hours only surfacing for the meals that mom has prepared.

Age and past experience have a lot to do with what children understand about cancer. While it may be tempting to use euphemisms like, "Mom will be going away," such vague words confuse kids. It is better to be clear about what is going to happen and address your child's fears. Be specific. Tell your child what kind of cancer you have.
